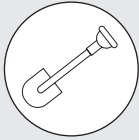


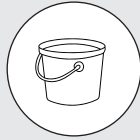

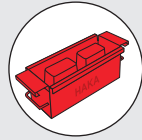
Wheel Barrow



Spade

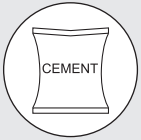

Haka Block Mould

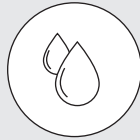
MATERIAL NEEDED:



*Cement



Sand



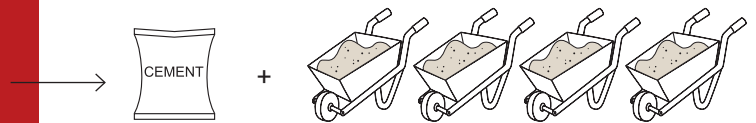
Water

*1 Bag of cement makes approximately 35 blocks.

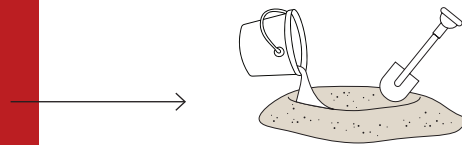


MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

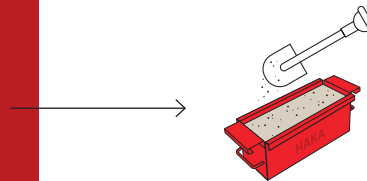
1. Mix 1 pocket of cement with 4 wheel barrows of sand.



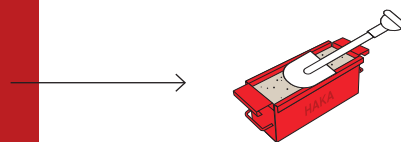
2. Add water and mix well until the mixture has a dryish consistency.



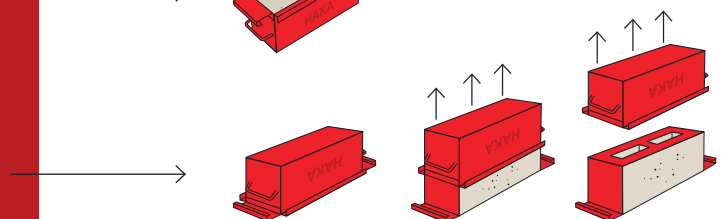
3. Fill the Haka Block Mould and compact down by bumping the mould on the ground 3-4 times.



4. Refill and compact with the back of a spade. Scrape off the excess mix with a spade or plank.



5. Turn upside down. Stand on the side levers. Lift the outer mould by pulling on the handles.



6. Remove the inner plate from the block.
